

PARKING INFORMATION FOR AUDITIONS AND CALLBACKS (rev. Aug. 14, 2019)

About Parking At SRJC

All parking for Santa Rosa Junior College is by permit or meter only. Parking regulations are strictly enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, even when very few people are on campus. This includes handicapped areas. A parking ticket is expensive so we don't recommend you risk it!

If you don't have a current SRJC parking permit, single usage parking permits (\$4.00; also known as "one day" permits) can be purchased at a grey kiosk (cash or card) located as you enter each lot. Permits are required 7 days a week, 24 hours a day. These daily permits are only valid for the calendar day they were purchased and cannot be used for metered spaces.

You can relocate your vehicle from one parking lot to another on campus using the same day permit on the same day.

If you encounter a permit machine that is not working, find another machine that is working. Please report the broken machine number and location to **District Police at 527-1000**. They are also the people to call if you encounter any problems or need help while on campus.

Where to Park for Preliminary Auditions

Audition registration and all preliminary auditions will be held at Lark Temporaries on the SRJC Santa Rosa Campus. Therefore, we recommend that you park nearby.

While SRJC is a relatively safe campus, we strongly recommend that actors walk together if you choose to walk around campus before/during/after auditions. There are fewer people on campus on the weekends and we want to make sure that you are safe. For the same reason, we don't advise parking off campus and walking to auditions alone. Bring a friend!

Parking near Lark Temporaries

- **Best Choice:** Parking spaces located along the side of the baseball field. This narrow lot can be accessed from Scholars Drive. There is also motorcycle parking at this location, next to the first Lark Temp. (*Since these spaces are next to the baseball field, be aware that there are occasionally foul balls that travel over the fence.*)
- **Second Best Choice:** New parking lot on the former tennis courts, just past Lark Temps via Scholars Drive. This brand new parking lot is for faculty/staff **ONLY** during the day Mon.-Fri., but available for students *after 3PM* on weekdays and all day on weekends. PLEASE CHECK THE SIGNS to make sure before you park.
- **Third Best Choice:** Bech Parking Lot, located next to Analy Village. This lot can be accessed from Planetarium Way. (*This is the lot with the solar panels overhead.*)
- **Fourth Best Choice** (...but only after 7PM): B Lot, located along Scholars Drive along the tennis courts and towards Bailey Hall. This is staff-only parking until 7PM Mon.-Fri.; it is open for parking on weekends, but we recommend the other choices.

Where to Park for Callbacks

Registration for all callbacks will be located at the Lark Temps, Rm. 2228T. Callbacks for *The Good Doctor* will also be held in the Lark Temporaries.

If you are called back for *The Sound of Music*, we will provide either a van shuttle service or walking escorts to/from Forsyth Hall and Tauzer Dance Studio for those auditions for those parked near the Lark Temporaries. However, if your musical callback is your last or only callback of the day/evening, once you are fully registered and have completed your callback orientation at the Lark Temporaries, you are welcome to relocate your car to that side of campus (a 2-minute drive).

Parking near Forsyth Hall and Tauzer Dance Studio

- **Best Choice:** Zumwalt Parking Pavilion, accessed from Bear Cub Way.
- **Second Best Choice:** Metered parking on Burbank Circle
The fee for parking in a metered space is \$1 per hour with a 1-hour maximum so they aren't ideal for longer callbacks.
- **Third Best Choice:** The parking lots at the south end of the football field and in front of Haehl Pavilion.
